#### Introduction:

Egypt-Japan University of Science and Technology (E-JUST) is a research university with an ambition to cultivate an academic environment and become a benchmark for the Egyptian and African countries in education. It was first established as a bilateral agreement project between the Egyptian and Japanese governments in May 2009 and later in 2010 it was ready to accept its first batch of students and make the dream a reality. - Duration: 6 Classes (18 hrs.)
- Level: Beginners (A1)

## **General Procedures**

#### **Application Deadline:**

May 31, 2023.

Once we receive your application form, upon acceptance, we will send you the acceptance notification and payment information through email.

#### Payment Deadline:

June 15, 2023.

Once the applicant received the notification of acceptance, the program fees must be paid in full within one week (5 working days)

#### Forms of Payment:

Through bank transfer. The bank information will be relied to the applicant by email along with the applicant's acceptance notification.

#### Q: Do students have to be more than 18 years old to be eligible?

A: Yes, we are currently targeting university students. However, accepting high school students might be possible in the upcoming programs.

#### Q: What is included in the Summer program's fees?

A: The program fees include; accommodation and meals inside of E-JUST, hotels in visited cities, on campus activates, transportation within Egypt and trips.

#### Q: What is excluded from the Summer program's fees?

A: The program fees does NOT include or cover the following; flight tickets and pocket money. Participants should expect additional fees minimum of 110 USD as their pocket money (or their equivalent in Egyptian pounds) in order to enjoy sightseeing, excursions and meals outside of E-JUST.

#### Q: Do the dormitories have kitchens that the students will be able to cook for themselves?

A: Yes, E-JUST dormitories have kitchens. In addition, students can enjoy food in E-JUST restaurants.

#### Q: Do I need high English communication skills for the program?

A: Intermediate English communication skills are enough for daily conversations during your stay in Egypt.

#### Q: Who is responsible for the visa application?

A: E-JUST will send the applicant an invitation letter after his/her acceptance then the applicant shall apply for the visa using this letter.

#### Q: Is there anyone who will pick the students from the airport?

A: An E-JUST staff and bus will be there to pick up the students from the airport.

#### Q: In case of emergencies, will medical assistance be provided?

A: A first Aid can be provided at E-JUST clinic on campus.

#### Q: Do I receive a certificate of completion of the program?

A: A certificate of achievement will be provided for the attendees at the farewell party on the last day of the program.
