

Fall 2019 Undergraduate Admission Guidelines for Faculty of Engineering (September 2019 Enrollment)

The Faculty of Engineering (FoE) welcomes applications to its undergraduate program through the E-JUST admission website. E-JUST undergraduate admission policy ensures equal opportunity to all applicants who meet the given criteria.

Admission decisions are made by the Admission Committee through students' performance on the below process, which examines his/her basic knowledge, skills and other qualities that help succeed in the FoE academic program.

Overall Application Procedure

2. Eligibility Requirements

- 1) Egyptian applicants must have completed a secondary school education and hold a valid THANAWYA AMMA certificate- Mathematics, or approved equivalent certificate (e.g. IGCSE, American Diploma, etc..).
- 2) Applicant's age must not exceed 21 years as of September 1, 2019. Male applicants have to provide their military service status.
- 3) Applicants from other countries must have an equivalent secondary school certificate approved by the Supreme Council of Universities of Egypt (SCU).
- 4) Foreign certificate holders should have completed at least 12 years of schooling or completed

3 years of secondary school after the Egyptian Preparatory school certificate (Eidadiya) or completed 6 years of secondary school and preparatory school after the Egyptian Primary school certificate as per the rules and regulation of the Egyptian Ministry of Higher Education.

- 5) Accepted students' holder of foreign certificates must pass the Arabic and Religion exams of Thanawya Amma before or after the final acceptance in the university.
- 6) Applicants must be able to read, write and communicate efficiently in English.

The followings are applied:

- All applicants must pass the E-JUST English Proficiency
 - Applicants who have TOEFL (iBT) score of 60 or IELTS score of 6.0 will be waived from the E-JUST English Proficiency Test. Only valid certificate will be accepted (the certificate validity is 2 years after the test date)
 - Applicants who did not pass the E-JUST English Proficiency Test might be enrolled in E-JUST as a provisional student for one academic year provided that he/she will pass the test within this year, otherwise the student enrollment will be terminated.
 - Provisional student can apply for 11 credit hours based on the university's academic schedule.
- 7) The University accepts applications from students who are holders of the following certificates:

THANAWYA AMMA CERTIFICATE (MATH SECTION):

- Students must have achieved an overall score of at least 80%.

STEM SCHOOLS (MATH SECTION):

- Students must have achieved an overall score of at least 75%.

THANAWYA AMMA/TAWGIHI CERTIFICATE FROM OTHER ARAB COUNTRIES (SCIENCE SECTION):

- Students must have achieved an overall score of at least 80% (as per the regulations and score calculation rules of the Ministry of Higher Education in Egypt).

THANAWYA AZHARIA CERTIFICATE (SCIENCE SECTION):

- Students must have achieved an overall score equivalent to 80% in Egyptian Thanaweya Amma. Religious subjects will not be considered.

BRITISH SCHOOLS (GCE/GCSE/IGCSE):

- Applicants must have successfully completed 12 years of schooling.
- Applicant must have achieved a minimum overall score of at least 80% in eight O-level (OL) subjects (including the qualifying subjects which are English or English Literature,

Math, Physics and Chemistry or Applied Chemistry) and a minimum of one A-level (AL) math subject or two Advanced Supplementary-level (ASL) subjects (Math is mandatory and the second subject should be one of Physics, Chemistry or Accounting).

- E-JUST accepts a minimum grade of C in O-level subjects, and a minimum grade of D in A-level and AS-level subjects. Repeated subjects will not be double counted. The best grade obtained in a repeated subject will be the only one considered, noting that the number of studied A-level and AS-level subjects will be considered and given a priority.
- IGCSE OL subjects should be from the extended system, not the core system. Up to five sittings is considered acceptable (taken over no more than three successive years).
- The equivalent score is calculated in compliance with Ministry of Higher Education regulations and score calculation rules.

AMERICAN HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA:

- Students must have achieved a minimum overall score of 80% in the high school.
- Students must have successfully completed eight different subjects (including the qualifying subjects which are English or English Literature, Math, Physics and Chemistry or Applied Chemistry). Subjects worth less than one credit will not be accepted.
- Subjects such as physical education, music, yearbook and religion will not be counted.. Subjects can be calculated from grade 11 (maximum of three subjects) and/or 12 (minimum five subjects).
- The minimum required score for acceptance is a combined total score of 1050/1600 in SAT I (1440/2400 old SAT I) and 1170/1600 in SAT II (1100/1600 old SAT II) with a minimum score of 500 for each qualifying subject.
- The qualifying subject in SAT II are Math and one of Physics, Chemistry or Biology. Students who receive an American High School Diploma must submit proof of 12 years of schooling.
- SAT II scores are not accepted after the graduation date from the high school.
- The equivalent score is calculated in compliance with Ministry of Higher Education regulations and score calculation rules.

CANADIAN DIPLOMA FROM SCHOOLS INSIDE EGYPT:

- Students must have achieved a minimum overall score of 80% in the high school.
- Students must have successfully completed eight different subjects (including the qualifying subjects which are English or English Literature, Math, Physics and Chemistry or Applied Chemistry). An advanced level Math subject in grade 12 is required. The subject must have also been studied in grade 11,

- Subjects worth less than one credit are not accepted.
- Subjects can be calculated from grade 11 (maximum of three subjects) and from grade 12 (minimum of five subjects). Subjects such as physical education, music, yearbook and religion will not be counted.
- The minimum required score for acceptance is a combined total score of 1050/1600 in SAT I (1440/2400 old SAT I) and 1170/1600 in SAT II (1100/1600 old SAT II) with a minimum score of 500 for each qualifying subject.
- The qualifying subject in SAT II are Math and one of Physics, Chemistry or Biology. Students who receive Canadian Diploma must submit proof of 12 years of schooling.
- SAT II scores are not accepted after the graduation date from the high school.
- The equivalent score is calculated in compliance with Ministry of Higher Education regulations and score calculation rules.

CANADIAN DIPLOMA FROM INTERNATIONAL SCHOOLS IN CANADA (EXCEPT THE QUEBEC PROVINCE):

- Students must have achieved a minimum overall score of 80% in the high school.
- Students must have successfully completed eight different subjects (including the qualifying subjects which are English or English Literature, Math, Physics and Chemistry or Applied Chemistry). An advanced level Math subject in grade 12 is required. The subject must have also been studied in grade 11.
- Subjects worth less than one credit will not be accepted.
- Subjects can be calculated from grade 11 (maximum of three subjects) and from grade 12 (minimum of five subjects). Subjects such as physical education, music, yearbook and religion will not be counted.
- The equivalent score is calculated in compliance with Ministry of Higher Education regulations and score calculation rules.

FRENCH BACCALAUREATE:

- Students must have achieved a minimum overall score of 80% in the high school.
- Seven subjects must be included in grade calculations (including the qualifying subjects which are English or English Literature, Math, Physics and Chemistry or Applied Chemistry). A minimum score of 10/20 is required as a passing grade.
- Five points will be added to each course in the evaluation as a bonus and the final percentage will be calculated according to the student's score in each course and the corresponding coefficient.
- The equivalent score is calculated in compliance with Ministry of Higher Education

regulations and score calculation rules.

GERMAN ABITUR:

- Students must have achieved a minimum overall score of 80% in the high school.
- Students must have taken the qualifying subjects in grade 11 and 12.
- Seven subjects must be included in grade calculations (including the qualifying subjects which are English or English Literature, Math, Physics and Chemistry or Applied Chemistry).
- The equivalent score is calculated in compliance with Ministry of Higher Education regulations and score calculation rules.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE:

- Students must have achieved a minimum overall score of 80% in the high school.
- Students must have passed six subjects, with a minimum of three taken at the high level including the qualifying subjects which are Mathematics and Physics. A minimum score of 24/45 is required as a passing score.
- Passing in English language is a must for acceptance. Theory of knowledge, extended essay and creativity are required subjects.
- Students must obtain the final graduation IB Diploma to be considered for admission.
- The equivalent score is calculated in compliance with Ministry of Higher Education regulations and score calculation rules.

OTHER CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS FOLLOW THE REGULATIONS AND SCORE CALCULATION RULES OF THE MINISTRY OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN EGYPT.

<Notes>

- ✓ Meeting the minimum requirement for application does not mean that the student will be automatically accepted to E-JUST. Students are required to pass the document screening, entrance examination and the final interview.
- ✓ Students acceptance is based on an overall assessment of the high school score, admission entrance exams score, English score and passing the interview.
- ✓ Incomplete applications will not be considered for final decision.
- ✓ Any deliberate falsifications or forgeries in the application process will result in immediate rejection.
- ✓ All correspondence during the admission process will be **done by email**, applicant should ensure registering with well-functioning email address and check it constantly, **including the junk-email box**.
- ✓ Submitted documents will not be returned for any reason.

Online Application Period:

Online submission is opened through E-JUST website from April 1 till July 31, 2019.

E-JUST will conduct the admission process as follows:

- Applicants will be divided into two groups based on the application submission date.
- The First group is for those who will apply from April till July 21, 2019.
- The second group is for those will apply from July 22 till July 31.

The applicant should submit the following documents:

- ◆ High school certificate or statements of results
- ◆ Birth certificate
- ◆ National ID or a passport copy
- ◆ Proof of English proficiency if available (test scores of IELTS or TOEFL)
- ◆ 4*6 photo with a white background
- ◆ University transcript in case of old date high school graduation
- ◆ Application fee of 1000 EGP

- ✓ Application fees must be paid to be considered. If fees not paid the application will be discarded.
- ✓ Applicant will upload the electronic copies of the relevant certificates, but the original (issued by the institution with a fresh stamp) will be required at the final admission.
- ✓ All correspondence during the exam process will be **done by email**, so please ensure you register the well-functioning email address and check constantly, **including the junk-email box**.

The 1st Screening announcement:

E-JUST will send the result to each applicant after documents classification and analysis on July 22, 2019 for the first group and on August 1, 2019 for the second group.

The accepted applicants for the 1st screening, will receive a notification by email with the guidance to take the exam (schedule, location, and access information).

Written Entrance Exams:

The entrance exams will be held on E-JUST campus in New Borg Alarab city, Alexandria on July 24, 2019 for the first group and on August 4, 2019 for the second group.

The 2nd Screening announcement:

E-JUST will notify by email the result to the applicants who passed the entrance exams on July 25, 2019 for the first group and on August 5, 2019 for the second group inviting them to the personal interview and informing about the schedule and the location.

Personal Interview:

The interview will be held in E-JUST campus in New Borg Alarab city, Alexandria on July 29, 2019 for the first group and on August 6, 2019 for the second group.

E-JUST will inform the applicants with the interview schedule.

Final Result Announcement

E-JUST will announce the interview result and final decision on July 31, 2019 for the first group and on August 8, 2019 for the second group.

Successful applicants must submit the original documents from August 1, 2019 to August 22, 2019 for the first group and from August 18, 2019 to August 22, 2019 to Admission Section, E-JUST Academic Affairs Office, and pay the tuition fees.

Detailed instructions will be notified for the successful applicants.

- ✓ Each subject exam will take an hour.
- ✓ All sections are mandatory.
- ✓ The exams do not reflect a specific curriculum.
- ✓ The exams are designed to measure the students' basic knowledge and understanding of relevant concepts.

3. Tuition Fees for FOE

- ◆ The annual tuition fee for FOE (Egyptian nationality) is **EGP 80,000** per year (after government subsidies) paid in two installments per semester with flat rate during the whole terms of study.
- ◆ The Provisional Students will pay the fee for English intensive course. The fee of the English intensive course is estimated as the fee of 2 credits hours of the FIBH students.
- ◆ The annual tuition fee for international students is **USD 15,000** per year paid in two installments per semester with flat rate during the whole terms of study.
- ◆ Upon request, on campus accommodation is available in single room occupancy with flexible meals plans
- ◆ A number of **tuition waiver and scholarships** are available according to the university scholarship policy.
